In response to the government-mandated elimination of productivity-pay employment, we strategically focused our efforts on the growth and success of our ACE Program. By year's end, we proudly served over 200 clients through ACE — offering dynamic opportunities in community access, discovery, education, and employment. A major milestone was the successful transition of 159 clients from our Work Activity Program into ACE, along with three clients who moved from ACE into Supported Employment. To support this growth, we expanded our team to a record 229 staff members, enabling us to meet rising demand while maintaining the high standard of quality that defines VIP.

We also celebrated a successful DDS audit, where our Program Services Team did an outstanding job demonstrating our services, procedures, and, most importantly, our clients' successes. Organizationally, we invested in our team like never before: implementing our HRIS system to enhance engagement and efficiency, launching updated staff handbooks and strategic plans, and conducting 62 training sessions focused on continuous professional development.

As we look to 2025, VIP is committed to further growth, not only within the ACE Program, but also through the expansion of our Supported Employment services. We are excited to now offer these services in both Orange County and San Diego County, and we believe the sky is truly the limit. As we grow, our focus on leadership development and succession planning remains strong. We will continue to invest in our staff with advanced technology, engaging training opportunities, and a personalized supportive environment where every employee has the opportunity to build a lasting future with us.

VIP's ACE Program is built on a commitment to individualized support, offering a low staff-to-client ratio that ensures personalized attention and a wide range of opportunities. The program emphasizes community integration and provides dynamic training experiences focused on education, independence, and pathways to employment.

Since 2023, ACE has experienced remarkable growth and now proudly serves over 200 clients across all three of its locations. The program features a diverse selection of engaging and creative activities, including job exploration, educational classes, community outings, and access to valuable local resources. Community access and integration are at the heart of VIP's ACE Program. The ultimate goal is to empower participants by fostering independence, enhancing social skills, improving overall well-being, and inspiring both new passions and employment aspirations.

ACE PROGRAM IN RANCHO CUCAMONGA

- started in May 2023
- by year end 2023, there were 17 clients enrolled
- by year end 2024, there were 102 clients enrolled

ACE PROGRAM IN SAN BERNARDINO

- started in July 2023
- by year end 2023, there were six clients enrolled
- by year end 2024, there were 64 clients enrolled

ACE PROGRAM IN HESPERIA

- started in March 2024
- by year end 2024, there were 36 clients enrolled
